

TC2/S4 – ORAL COMPREHENSION (2018-19)



- We all know what a TED Talk is: speakers are given a limited amount of time to present their “ideas worth spreading” in an engaging way. This semester, your group will present its own TED Talk.
- Your talk may be on a topic of your choice.
- You will make 7-10 questions based on your talk, which the class will complete during the presentation (true/false, fill in the blanks, multiple choice, short answer...).

Just like last semester, each group should email me their preparation the week before by Friday 10 pm.

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PLEASE INCLUDE YOUR GROUP NUMBER IN YOUR EMAIL

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You will send me:

- (1) a Word file without the answers;**
- (2) a separate Word file with all of the answers filled in.**

- Your TED Talk should be 10-12 minutes (you may use PowerPoint or any other tool to enhance your presentation. Remember, the goal is to make it as engaging as possible)

Assessment:

- 10 points on the questions + answers sent – **25%**
- 10 points on the TED Talk – **25%**
- Listening comprehension test (last class) – **50%**

As in semester 3, you will lose one point per day that your document is sent late.
