(TP, semester2) **SERIES PROJECT**

Here's the information about the "series project" in English, to be followed carefully.

1. You'll be asked to present a series in English individually in TP, as personally as possible - DO NOT READ OUT THE WIKIPEDIA SUMMARIES TO THE CLASS! In each TP group, each student should pick a different series.

Duration: between 10 and 20 minutes (the more complete, the better, of course!), plus the excerpt. The presentation should be as visual as possible.

Do NOT read - even on your phone - except for figures, dates or names.

- **2.** To introduce your series, in order to attract the others' attention, try to find a catch phrase, or show the picture of a character, or play the soundtrack, or use any other original way.
- **3**. The following parts can be presented in any order you like.
- To give an idea of the atmosphere and genre of the series, show a short excerpt, in English- 1 to 2 mn maximum, that can be made of 2 shorter excerpts -, but NOT the trailer.
- Explain the context of this excerpt again, as personally as possible and present the main characters, focusing on your favorite one/ones or most hated one/ones, why not? by explaining personally why you've picked them up.
- Present some facts and figures about the series: genre, release date, producer (mention if he/she has produced other series or movies), director (mention if he/she has directed other series or movies), channel, number of seasons, number of viewers, how successful it has been try to find the total income, if you can -, some fun facts if available, and so on.
- Explain as completely as possible why you've picked up this series, why you enjoy watching it or hate it, and why you would recommend it to your friends.

Assessment wil be based on how personal your presentation was, your enthusiasm, the quality of your grammar and vocabulary in English as well as your fluency and accent, the quality of your Powerpoint and your oral communication skills.
